SUPPORT ON THE ROAD OF LIFE

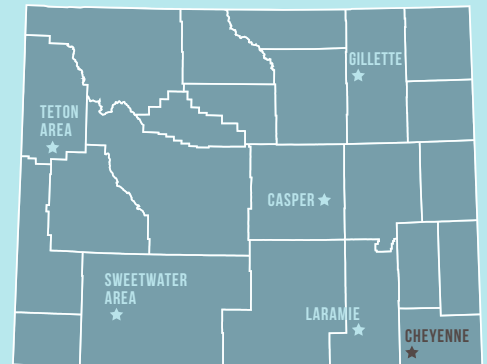
