READY TO MAKE A CHANGE

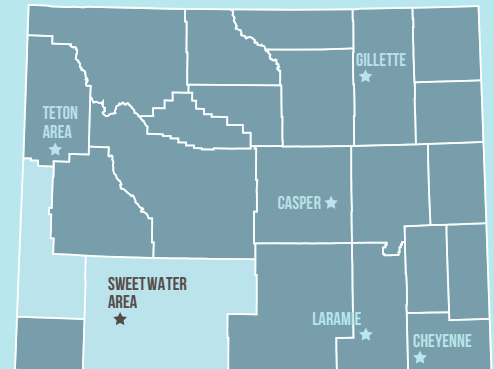
