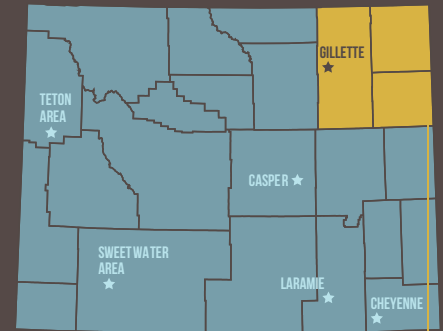
“Being a single mother can feel very isolating, so these women came to Climb really wanting to connect with other moms. It meant a lot to them to go through this experience together.
