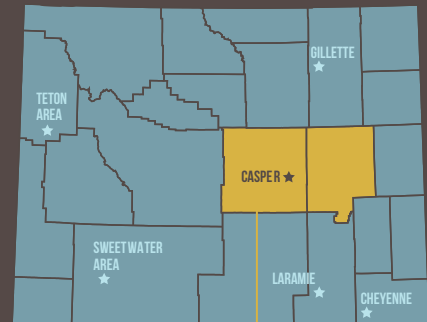
“During the program, the women grew to trust and support each other, which helped them learn and excel. Several said that they had never received so much support before in life and were able to create friendships and bonds that will last.
