## A SENSE OF ACHIEVEMENT

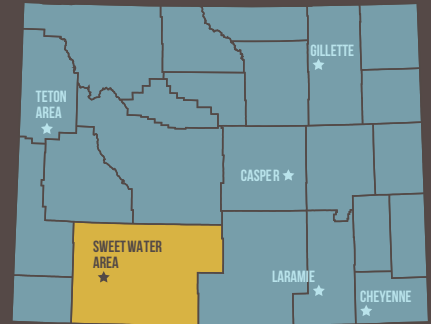
