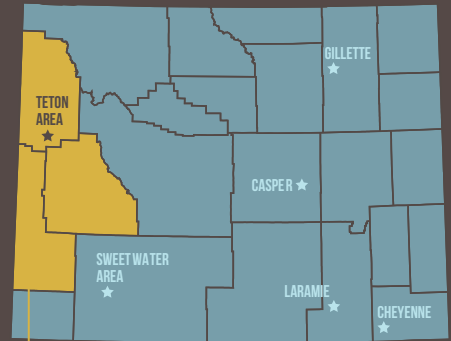
### A NEW DIRECTION IN LIFE
